"Marine Elevator Fire Door and Frame Assembly (A-60)" is a Class A-60 single leaf hinged elevator fire door with window tested and approved in accordance with IMO FTP Code, Annex 1, Part 3.

Approved for use as an integrated part of fire resisting divisions of Class "A-60". Maximum door leaf width of 1213 mm and height of 2124 mm. Door frame may be bolted or welded to bulkhead per manufacturer's instructions. Maximum window (clear opening) dimensions of 127 x 286 mm (width x height). Door may be constructed with a stepped or flat threshold. Door material may be constructed Stainless Steel (#304, #316) or Mild Steel with or without Galvaneal Finish. An elevator interlock option is approved for installation.
